Drugs Subject to Medicaid Pharmacy Prior Authorization Programs

In order to receive payment for services rendered, all pharmacies must submit their transactions through the **online** Pro-DUR program using the NCPDP transaction format. The online system is designed to allow for capture and adjudication of the electronic submission. For drugs identified as having utilization management requirements* (prior authorization, Step Therapy, Frequency/Quantity/Duration), claims must be <u>submitted as a real time transaction</u> (date of adjudication/submission = date of service). Authorizations will **not** be issued retroactively.

As a reminder, all enrolled pharmacies MUST participate in the mandatory Prospective Drug Utilization Program (ProDUR) to receive reimbursement. Important ProDUR information can be accessed online at <u>www.eMedNY.org</u>. Click on Provider Manuals and select the Pharmacy Manual.
